Hi Terry

I was wondering if you would please confirm our conclusion of the new adoption of the ADA code.

It is our understanding that as of March 1st, according to the a document on the BCD website called the “2010 ADA Update” that the state of Oregon is adopting 2009 IBC accessibility code and over writing it with Oregon amendments in the OSSC Chapter 11. In the new OSSC amended Chapter 11, there are scoping rules and code, but refers “technical” or in our case measurements to plumbing fixtures, are to be governed by the ICC/ANSI A117.1-2003 So, I can use and hand out to our plumbers the ICC/ANSI A117.1-2003 Chapter 6 standards because that is what the inspectors will be looking for as of March 1st, 2012.

Is this correct please?
